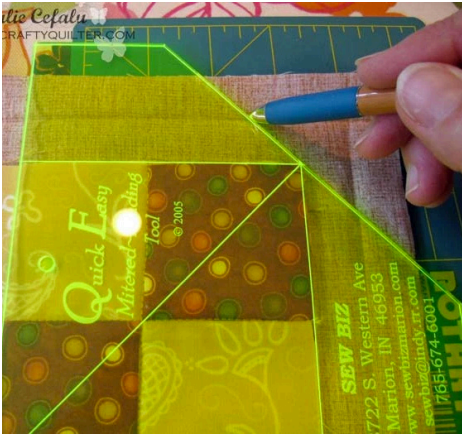


Binding: Easy Miter - Using Backing Fabric



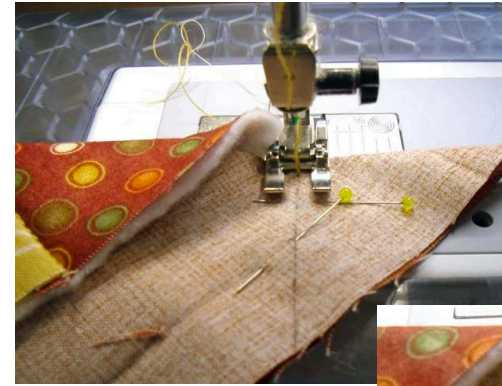
- Place the mitered binding tool in the corner, matching up the lines on the ruler with the quilt top corner and draw a line along the top edge as shown:



- Draw a line where the previous line intersects with the crease that was formed during pressing. This will form a slanted "X" at the intersection.



- Fold the corner back on itself with right sides together and pin. Make sure the pin goes through both "X's" that were formed previously to ensure that the lines match up.



- Stitch on the drawn line from fold to the crease, backstitching at beginning and end.



- Trim seam allowance 1/4" from stitching.

- Turn the stitched corner to the inside so that a miter is formed.
- Repeat steps on all corners.
